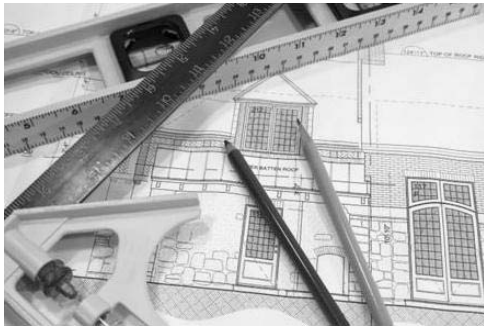
**Touch-a-Truck Event**
