**Anthony Perugino** was born in Bristol, Connecticut on February 3rd, 1917, and was recently honored by his friends and neighbors on his 100th birthday. Tony has been a resident of the Village of Palm Springs since 1993. He spent 4 years serving America in the United States Army where he rose to the rank of Corporal and worked for 35 years in the Engineering Department at the Barnes Group, an international aerospace and industrial manufacturer and services provider. He volunteered two days a week for the Veteran's Affairs Hospital in Riviera Beach since it opened in 1995, donating over 5,000 hours of service.



Tony is also a longtime member of the Palm Springs Travel Club, the American Legion, and Disabled American Veterans. Vice Mayor Joni Brinkman presented Tony with a Proclamation at the February 9th Village Council Meeting on behalf of the Mayor and Council along with a cupcake and balloons. ## ***Village to Pave Remaining Shell-rock Roads***



The Village of Palm Springs has scheduled road paving work to be completed during the month of March for the following streets;

- **Lone Pine Way**
- **Childs Street**
- **Erie Terrace**
- **Sally Lane**

These streets are the only remaining shell-rock roads left in the Village. The asphalt paving is part of our comprehensive road maintenance program in order to provide all of our residents with a safe network of streets for both motorists and for non-motorized modes of transportation. The construction should commence **Monday, March 13th and conclude by the end of April**. There may be some periodic lane closures on east bound Lake Worth Rd., but these will be limited and conducted during non-rush hours. ### **Get your taxes filed FREE at the Palm Springs Public Library**

Volunteers from the United Way of Palm Beach County are on site at the Palm Springs Library on Wednesdays from 3:00 to 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. as part of the "[Volunteer Income Tax Assistance \(VITA\)](#)" program, which will continue through mid-April when Personal Income Taxes are due to the Internal Revenue Service. There will be no AARP Tax Assistance offered in the Library this year.

This service is available to those with annual household income of less than \$62,000 and focus on those who might be eligible to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) of up to \$6,239. Last year the VITA program in Palm Beach County prepared over 10,000 tax returns for \$16.1M of refunds and saved over \$1.5M in preparation fees.
