Approved an "Hours of Operation" waiver for Racetrac Gas Station/Store to located on the southwest corner of Lake Worth Road and South Congress Avenue, to allow a 24 hour operation.

Approved four sign variances to allow additional awnings and price lettering for RaceTrac Gas Station/Store, to be located on the southwest corner of Lake Worth Road and South Congress Avenue.

Approved a Labor Agreement with Palm Beach County Police Benevolent Association (PBA) for October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2015, for all police officers and Sergeants.

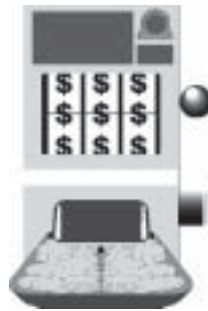

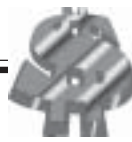

Filing will be held during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The filing fee is \$178.00 for Mayor and \$166.00 for a Council seat.
